Join us for worship in the Chapel at 7 p.m. as we begin the season of Lent.


#### **LENTEN STUDY**

Do you want to grow deeper in your walk with God? Do you want to experience more vitality in your life with Christ? During Lent, we will begin an excellent six-week video-based study called *The Walk*, by Adam Hamilton, which will help us do just that. In a clear and practical way, Hamilton teaches about five essential Christian practices (worship, study, serving, giving, and sharing our faith) and how to apply them to our lives.

This series will start on Sunday, March 1, at the 10:45 a.m. Adult Ed time, and run for six Sundays – ending on Palm Sunday. We will watch the video for each week, followed by small group discussions.

We encourage you to read the accompanying hardcover book, *The Walk*, by Hamilton, to help you glean more from the study, but it is not necessary for joining the Sunday morning videos. The books will be available for \$10 in the Narthex and Church Office starting on Sunday, February 9.
