# Call to Confession

God, your love for us is unfathomably deep, that you would take all our failures and still love us as friends. May we take the gift of your forgiveness and share it with the world that you made and loved so much. Amen.

## **Assurance of Forgiveness**

Leader: Friends, the story we tell tonight is a story of the deepest love; love that would offer forgiveness even to the traitor at its right hand. The bread was for us; the cup, for us; the cross, for us. We are forgiven, not easily, but the hard way. We are forgiven, not cheaply, but wholly.
