

Siblings in Christ, our baptism is the sign and seal of our cleansing from sin, and of our being grafted in Christ. Through our baptism we were made citizens of God's kingdom and freed from the bondage of sin. Let us celebrate that freedom and redemption through the renewal of the promises made at our baptism.
