#### THE LORD'S SUPPER

#### Invitation to the Lord's Table

Leader: Come to this table, prepared for all who seek hope and peace. In this season of waiting, we remember the promise of Emmanuel - God with us. This table is not ours to give or withhold; it is Christ's table, and he invites all who long for grace and renewal.

> Come, not because you are perfect, but because you are loved. Come, not because you have all the answers, but because you are searching.

> Come, bringing your joys and your burdens, your faith and your doubts, for here Christ meets you with open arms.

> The bread is broken, the cup is poured, and the feast is ready. Let us share together in this holy meal as we prepare our hearts for the coming of the Lord. All is ready - come and taste and goodness of God.

## The Great Thanksgiving

One: The Lord be with you. All: And also with you. One: Lift up your hearts.

One: Let us give thanks to the Lord, our God. All: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

Make them be for us the body and blood of Christ, that we may be for the world the body of Christ, redeemed by his blood. Make us a Christmas people. secure in what has come and hopeful for what is yet to be. By your Spirit, make us one with Christ, one with each other, and one in ministry to all the world. Keep us vigilant in our Advent waiting until Christ comes in final victory and we feast at his heavenly banquet. Through your Son Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit in your holy Church, all honor and glory is yours, Almighty God, now and forever. Amen.
